
## From the President


Just when we thought 2020 couldn't get any crazier, the year definitely keeps trying to outdo itself.

#### **COVID APP**

Devil Dog Installations wanted to find a resourceful COVID-19 application that would be easy to implement and use. Rebecca Uyleman said "with our installers traveling to various job sites, we felt this application would be imperative to not only secure our employees safety, but our company as a whole. This COVID-19 application is extremely affordable and collects necessary data for proper documentation." She went on to say that "it's an app on employees' phones. They note daily their temperatures, any symptoms and clear themselves for work, etc. This protects our company from any liability. This data is stored and only an administrator to the app has access – it's a log. Since installers are all over the place, it's a good way to protect them and the company."

Rebecca has been a staunch advocate of documentation during this pandemic and has been very happy with the Covid app so far. She listed the steps below that are used on a daily basis for the installers. Check it out when you get a chance.

- 1. Daily login via phone app or desktop
- 2. Login username and password (if not saved)
- 3. Click on "Screening Questionnaire"
- 4. Answer questions
- 5. It then tells you if you are at risk to yourself or others
- 6. Click "Go Home"
- 7. It takes you to a "Task" page
- 8. Click on if you are practicing social distancing
- 9. Then log in your temperature
- 10. Then Click on "Sign and Submit." This holds the employee accountable for the data they provided
- 11. All this data is kept and I am the Administrator for the company so can see the daily logs and keep records for liability protection.

#### SOFTWARE DESCRIPTION

The pilot software is an easier-to-use version of 3M<sup>TM</sup> Graphics Install Wizard, intended to help you plan and manage installations more easily to close jobs faster.

Wizard 2.0 pilot software has several improvements, including built-in messaging, job editing to accommodate changes, and a redesigned dashboard (shown at right) to help you quickly find and open specific jobs.

#### **PILOT PARTICIPANTS**

We'd like all 230+ UASG members to participate as installation service providers for national coverage. And, we need 8-10 UASG members that are also graphic manufacturers

#### **PILOT ACTIVITIES**

Graphic manufacturers (GMs) will use the software to:

- Create real jobs by inputting job details and uploading files
- Search for UASG installation providers and agree pricing, installation date, etc. and award jobs
- Assign some jobs to their in-house installers
- Update/edit jobs when job details change, as needed
- Review completion photos to confidently close jobs

Installation service providers that receive job opportunities from GMs will use the software to:

- Review and respond to incoming job opportunities
- Prepare for jobs by reviewing job details and files
- Assign jobs to a specific installer
- Take/upload completion photos for the GM to review for approval

#### TIMING AND OTHER INFORMATION

We will on-board participants in late-September and offer several web-meeting options for an intro and quick training.

Participants will start using Wizard 2.0 in mid-October and continue for 45-60 days. We'll finish sooner if you complete a lot of jobs and your feedback is relatively consistent.

We know you're busy, so we'll gather feedback in ways that require minimal effort by you.

We'll work closely with the UASG Board of Directors to keep them informed of pilot progress and outcomes.

Finally, we will protect your privacy and all sensitive information abiding by the terms of service we developed with input from Chris Prenovost.

#### 3M Commercial Solutions Division 3M Diversity Scholarship

Applications are due by September 22, 2020

The 3M Commercial Solutions Division will provide up to three (3) scholarships to attend the 3-day 3M Advanced Installer Training class based on the submitted applications from 3M's graphics installer network. The scholarship is for the 3-day hands-on course for no charge and will include some free tools that will be provided at the end of the class.

The goal of this scholarship is to encourage our installation community to consider hiring more from minority groups and the individual scholarships will be awarded to companies that are establishing programs to support hiring diverse talent. Local community needs will also be considered such as hiring veterans or refugees.

Companies will be categorized as small, medium and large based on typical size of our installation companies and by the range of scholarship applicants. The goal is to award a scholarship to a company from each one of these categories.

#### Award:

Scholarship to 3M Advanced Installer Training 3-day course (normal cost of \$1,500/person). Courses scheduled through 2021. Travel and hotel are not included

#### Who Can Participate:

3M will consider 3M Certified Graphics Installation companies and employers of 3M Preferred graphics installers. These companies should demonstrate their hiring programs and practices to hire diverse talent on the application. The hiring of minority or diverse employees during 2020 will also be considered.

#### Some examples of programs are the following:

- A company's hiring program(s) established to increase workforce diversity
- A company's hiring program(s) established to recruit and hire minority individuals
- Other relevant factors and results could be considered during judging

#### New E-mail Scam

There's a nefarious entity who has registered an internet domain name that looks very similar to ours, kayser-roth.com. They are using kayser-roths.com. They are using this to impersonate us in emails to other businesses and perform the common scams related to redirecting invoices, banking information, etc. This particular attack is a form of phishing called typosquatting.

We're addressing this appropriately on our end, but due to the nature of this method, we do not have any immediate recourse to shut their operation down other than reporting the abuse to the appropriate authorities. Please be diligent! if you notice suspicious behavior in an e-mail chain, look for this mis-spelling in the email address of those you're communicating with.
